

# **BYLAWS OF INSPIRATION POINT VOLUNTEER FIRE ASSOCIATION, INC.**

As amended December 1983, December 1985, December 1986, December 1995, and December 2010

**A.** Inspiration Point Volunteer Fire Association, Inc. (the "Corporation") is and shall be a group of persons bonded together and associated for the benefit of all.

**B.** The Corporation was incorporated under the domestic non-profit laws of the state of Arkansas on February 9, 1981.

**C.** The purpose for which the Corporation was organized is to acquire and own fire apparatus for the use by the Corporation in the protection of persons and property from injury, loss, damage, or destruction by fire, to own and acquire land and to construct and erect buildings for Corporation purpose, for the use of members of the Corporation in connection with the housing of fire apparatus and emergency medical service equipment and for providing a place of meeting for members of the Corporation and for firefighters and emergency medical technicians serving the Inspiration Point Rural Fire Protection District (the "District"), to seek donations and grants of money from any person who may wish to subscribe and pledge money for the purpose of purchasing fire and EMT equipment necessary for the protection of the District. The Inspiration Point Volunteer Fire Association Auxiliary shall be incorporated into the District.

**D.** Membership consists of qualified electors residing within the District.


**E.** The business affairs of the Corporation shall be discharged in a manner that is consistent with and supports the business affairs of the District. To that end, the board of commissioners of the District shall be the board of directors of the Corporation, the officers of the District shall be the officers of the Corporation, and the rules and regulations of the District shall regulate the operations of the Corporation concerning the powers and duties of the board of directors and officers, the notice of, time and conduct of meetings of the board of directors and membership, the conduct of the fiscal affairs of the Corporation and all other matters. Any rule or bylaw of the Corporation may be altered by the Board of Directors.
